The IB curriculum consists of 6 academic subject groups, along with the core elements of Extended Essay. Theory of Knowledge, and Creativity Activity Service. Students study a subject from each of the groups (at least three of these at the High Level (HL) and remainder at the Standard Level (SL). We offer non-regular diploma, if required.

School Policy on College Applications:

Predicted grades: These are not based on any single examination. They are generated on the basis of algorithm as follows:

Grade X Board marks: 25%

- Grade XI Final Term exam only: 20%
- Grade XII Term I or II examination: 40%

Teacher's (subject teacher) discretion: 15%

For IB students, the predicted grades are out of 45. Term 1 marks of Grade XII (Grade IX, X, XI final results) are transcribed in the initial transcript. Pre-board marks are transcribed for mid-year report.

ISC board marks are transcribed for the final transcript.

Early Decision Policy: If a student decides to undertake an Early Decision application, the school informs the student that if accepted it is mandatory to commit to that college/university and withdraw all other the applications.
